- The latest techniques in joint replacement including minimally invasive approaches (which allow the patients to leave the same day as surgery in many cases), hip resurfacing, and complex hip revisions.

## Midwest Orthopaedics at Rush — Foot and Ankle

The foot and ankle surgeons of MOR are board certified orthopaedic surgeons who have advanced fellowship training in foot and ankle surgery. Dr. Holmes, Dr. Lee, and Dr. Lin provide comprehensive surgical and nonsurgical approaches to the treatment of foot and ankle problems. In situations that require surgical intervention, these surgeons are highly skilled in procedures such as the new osteotomy-sparing bunion procedure originated at Rush, total ankle replacement, cartilage replacement, tendon repair, arthroscopic procedures, diabetic limb salvage, and complex reconstructive procedures. They are also proficient in the care of arthritic disorders, heel pain, traumatic injuries, and sportsrelated conditions.

The MOR foot and ankle doctors have also served as educators and volunteers in both the local and national medical community. They participate in educational activities for medical students, residents, orthopaedic and non-orthopaedic physicians, nurses, physician assistants, workers' compensation case managers, occupational therapists, physical therapists, podiatrists, and orthotists.

These physicians have served as consultants to organizations such as local high school and college teams, local club sports, the Chicago Marathon, the Chicago Triathlon, the Joffrey Ballet, River North Dancers, Hubbard Street Dance, the DePaul Blue Demons, Chicago White Sox, and the Chicago Bulls.
